

The off-season Academy operates through the months of June and July and is designed to help young players build confidence and work on the technical, tactical and mental aspects of their game.



<p>TECHNICAL</p> 	<p>Cricket is a very technical game and our experienced coaches will put your batting technique under the microscope in our 'Batting Lab'. They will work through your batting set up and lay the foundations to help you generate more power and score runs to every part of the ground. You will work through the full array of shots (front foot and back foot) plus address how to play spin. The coaches will also examine your bowling action and address injury prevention plus how to generate more pace, spin or variation.</p>	
<p>TACTICAL</p> 	<p>In the weekly group training sessions we challenge players by creating game day scenarios to simulate pressure situations. The sessions are designed to get players 'match ready' which means working balls into gaps, turning the strike over, dropping and running, hitting boundaries and improving running between wickets. Bowlers also work on match day strategies including how to bowl at the 'death' plus set their own fields. They are taught how to create more variation with their bowling and focus on executing their skills with yorkers, slower balls, in-swingers, out-swingers (pace bowlers) while the spin bowlers work on generating more spin, drift and variation (wrong-un etc.)</p>	
<p>MENTAL</p> 	<p>Cricket is a tough game that punishes lapses in concentration and small errors. You need to be a team player, bring a positive attitude and learn how to manage pressure and setbacks. Players also need to build resilience and be mentally strong to deal with the inevitable game day 'failures' and disappointment.</p> <p>The game also teaches players valuable life lessons including, the harder you work, the luckier you get. Success builds confidence (on and off the ground) and cricket is more than a game, it's a microcosm of life. The skills players learn stay with them for life.</p>	

The Academy provides a professional and disciplined learning environment and aims to develop and enhance the skills of each and every young cricketer in the programme. Cricket HQ and our qualified and experienced coaches have a proven record of producing representative players with a number of players going on to play Premier Cricket and represent Victoria and Australia in under-age teams.
